Latin pop superstar Shakira Isabel Mebarak Ripoll was born on February 9, 1977 in the Colombian city of Barranquilla. Leaving her family at the age of 13, Shakira moved to Bogota to become a model and emerged with a recording contract for Sony. Her debut album *Magia* which consisted entirely of self-written songs released in 1991 when she was just 14. Like its successor *Peligro*, the album wasn't very successful. So, she appeared on the Colombian soap - opera *El Oasis* beginning in 1994, but returned to music the following year.

In 1995, Shakira recorded "*Pies Descalzos*" and its initial popularity appeared quite fleeting. Several months after the album's release, the single "*Estoy Aqui*" gained airplay around Latin America. It eventually hit number one on the Latin music charts. Four additional single - "*Antologia*", "*Pienso en Ti*", "*Un Poco de Amor*" - reached the Top Ten and *Pies Descalzos* hits the top spot in eight different countries selling over four million copies. "*Los Donde Esta Codrones*" followed in 1998 and in early 2000 she issued *MTV unplugged*. She was on her way of getting international celebrity during this time. Shakira won a Grammy for Best Female Pop Vocal Performance for "*Ojos Asi*" at the first annual Latin Grammy Awards in the fall of 2000.

Shakira's first "Cross Over" and her fifth album titled "*Laundry Service*" (2002), reflects her feelings. She wanted to express her two passions- music and love-without leaving her Colombian/ Cebanese roots. The album features her first English language hit, "*Whenever wherever*" and its successful version, "*Sucrte.*" "*Underneath your clothes*". It is another smashing number that can be enjoyed. After a few dances of pop tunes, the power ballad "The



One" arrives with unusual strength, taking listeners to female side of rock "en espanol" scene. The belly dance inspired "*Eyes like Yours*" came as its original, "*Ojos Asi*", once performed live at the Latin Grammy's ceremony. Singer and song writer Shakira wants to captivate a new legion of followers with her passionate compositions, moving people to understand a simple message of loving care in her own way.

Shakira has been dazzling Latin pop fans for years and her vocal inflection has been compared to Alanis Morissette and she's also been labeled the Latin singer Britney Spears. Lyrically Shakira is far more poetic and romantic. Moreover, her Colombian and Lebanese roots can be heard throughout her songs.

Laundry Service serves up some hearty pop power ballads, adult alternative pop/rock and some good old Latin pop and rocks "en esponal." All instruments are played by a live band. It includes dance pop hit "*Whenever Wherever*", the rock ballad "*The one*" and the belly dancing aura of "*Eyes like Yours*". Shakira's music has a passionate, sophisticated originality that sets her apart from the rest of her field. Let's hope her talents are actually noticed behind the marketing smoke screen.

THE ARTIFICIAL HEART

But only 8 months later, on April 4, 1969, he placed such a device in a 47 years old man- the first such operation in medical history.

Designed and built by Dr. Domingo Liotta of the Baflor college of Medicine, the artificial heart was about the same size as a normal human heart and weighted a half pound (a human heart weighte three fourths of a pound). Plastic tubes to a power unit outside the patient chest linked it. Carbon dioxide was pumped through the tubes to provide synchronized pressure on the outsides of the ventricles, thus causing these two pumping chambell to function in the same manner as a real human heart. This mechanical heart was implanted only to keep the planet alive until a donor could be found; three days later a human heart replaced it.

The artificial heart worked properly and the patient, Mr. Haskell Karop, did extremely well. Two hours after the operation he was conscios and could obey command to nod his head. Then he lifted his hand and wiggled his toes. The next morning, after a breathing tube was removed from his throat, he spoke briefly.

Early on April 7, the artificial heart was replaced by a human heart. The complete transfer of the heart from the

donor to Mr. Karp took 2 hours and 45 minutes. A single electric shock started the heart beating and doctors were optimistic about the patients' chances of survival. But, the next day he died, primarily of pneumonia and kidney failure.

Dr. Liotta's artificial heart was made of a silicone plastic and lined with Dacron-durable materials which theoretically should enable it to work indefinitely. Synthetic material damage the blood cells and others blood substances. Research is being conducted for the development of a synthetic substance that will be so compatible with blood that no damage will occur.

Dr. Frank W. Hastings of the National heart Institute estimates that 700,000 Americans die of heart diseases each year. Of these 250,000 die in hospitals and have no other complicating conditions, thus making them ideal recipients of new hearts. If mechanical devices such as artificial heart could be permanently placed in a human being, these would no longer be a need for human donors. Will such devices become substitutes for diseased organs in the years to come? If so what will be the limit to the number of mechanical organs one person may have in his body?

"The mechanical heart borders on science fiction and is wishful thinking."

Dr. Denton A. Coolerf spoke these words on August 3, 1968. Dr. Coolerf from the Baylor college of Medicine and St. Luker's Episcopla Hospital in Houston, Texas, furthermore added "it would be 3 to 5 years before an artificial heart could be developed".

Biology is the most visual of all the sciences. Many of its principal concepts find direct expressions in drawings or diagrams: the cell, the phylogenetic tree, the double helix. Unlike physics, which seeks to analyze entities into their component parts, biology seeks to treat overall properties, it represents the entire living system rather than simply illustrate its isolated parts.

The biologist must regard his subject with close attention, seeking to fathom its essential character while rejecting superficial impressions that might mislead his inquiry. Now where

is this truer than at the limits of vision, in the interpretation of microscopic forms through which so many of the great discoveries of the past century have been made? The early stages of embryonic development, the character of cell division, and the environmental responses of bacteria have come to be understood the subtlest aspects of visual evidence about exceedingly minute organisms.

Therefore, biology, the science of living organism, perceives a great truth directly by studying the visual aspect of organisms. The natural aspects of primary consequences are of all subsequent organisms picturized in

biology. Biology, which is regarded as "life science", is the unit that helps and leads in many great discoveries and research programmes for the sake of entire living organisms as well as other sciences.

Thinking deeply, many biologist and scientist, found biology as the base of 'scientific facts' and "Portrait of organic nature." Many of them say, "Biology is a picture from which truth is directly perceived by standing the visual aspect of organisms." Further more, biology hasn't only one form. It's like chewing gum which can be expanded in our desirable form. So, it can be regarded as the source of songs, poems.

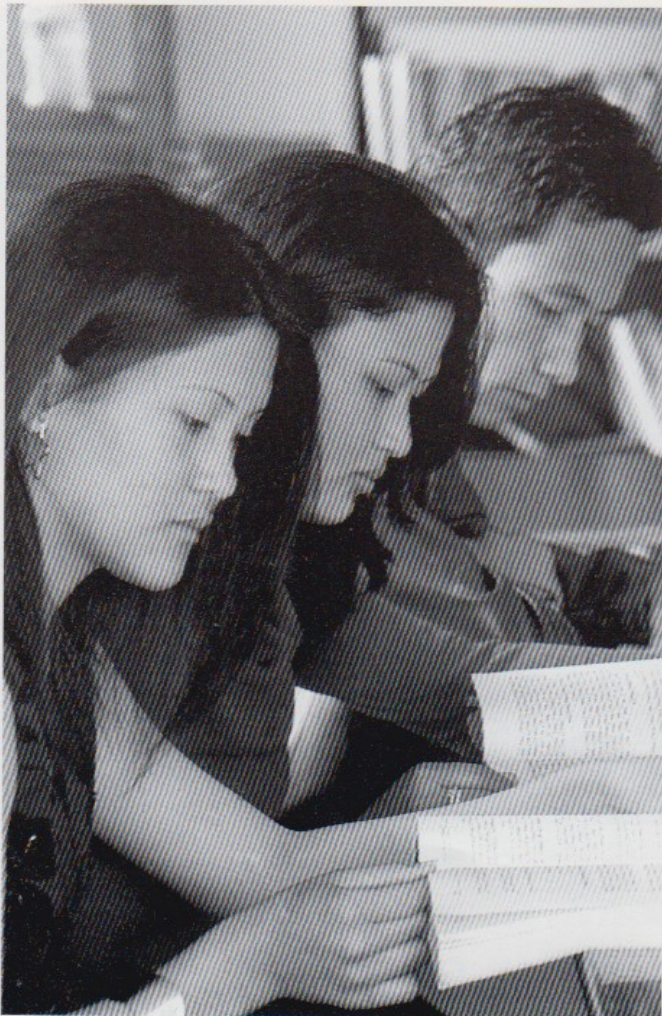
Since 4 September 1994, Kansai International Airport (KIA) is one of only two artificial structures visible from space- the other is the Great Wall of China. The purpose of this project was to build Japan's first 24 hours international airport, in order to facilitate the increased demand of such air transport in entire country. Three mountains in the southeastern part of Japan's Osaka Bay had to be leveled to provide the landmass, and Kansport bridges. For this purpose the 5k.m. long harbour also had built. The cost and constructional difficulties of this ambitious undertaking were outweighed by the need of peaceful flight site. The island is fully operational. It was only the end of Phase 1. Plans for phase 2 will increase the size of the island adding further two runways.

HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION AND PARENTS' DESIRE

Most of the parents possess a strong desire to see their wards becoming doctors and engineers. Such a desire might have been inspired either from economic point of view considering the income earning scope of trained people like doctors and engineers or with a view to seeing the nation getting prosperous in terms of skilled manpower needed for the development of our country. Whatever the reason, no nation can be developed in the absence of skilled manpower needed for different factors of society. It is for this reason that we need quality education to make our nation able to compete with other nations.

Our products of schools and colleges reveal the quality of our education system. Every nation must have its own strong education policy. In our case, the government seems to have decided to phase out certificate level course from the university and make the 10 +2 education as part of the basic education. However, the government does not seem serious in this regard.

After the students pass ten class, known as S.L.C. till now, some parents want their wards to take up the subjects in accordance with their desire, irrespective of the latter's inclination. If there is disagreement between the wards and parents, the latter should respect the feeling of the former. Imposing parents' will on the wards might be counter productive to concerned students as well as the nation, which expects fruitful return from the educated manpower.



His majesty's government has failed to make the 10 +2 education as part of school education till now. This uncertain situation has put various 10 + 2 schools opened up at level in great dilemma. In the countryside, local people are bearing the burden of salary for the teacher teaching in 10 +2 schools because of government's vague policy. Thus, 10+2 has become dearer than the certificate level education. Government is unclear how it is going to solve the surplus of teachers of the university in case its certificate level is phased out. On the other, students groups are also protesting the policy of phase out plan of the government.

The village level 10+2 schools have solved the problem of going to cities for higher education, but they are below the standard because of the lack of qualified lecturers and also due to

lack of adequate number of teachers. In the absence of concrete government policy, there is an unfair competence in opening up new 10 +2 school in town and cities. Higher Education Board needs to frame concrete policies in this regard. If correct policies are adapted, unfair competition can be minimized considerably. On the one hand, the parents must give freedom to their offspring to choose the subjects of their interest and on the other hand, government should utilize the services of skilled manpower for the overall development of the country. Higher education can be meaningful only with the joint efforts of government and the nation's skilled manpower.
